# Peak Smoke Alarm Campaign



## Did you know...?

- You are four times more likely to die in a fire if you don't have working smoke alarms.
- Around half of home fires are caused by cooking fires.
- Two fires a day are started by candles.
- Every six days someone dies from a fire caused by a cigarette.
- Two fires a day are started by heaters.
- Faulty electrics (appliances, wiring and overloaded sockets) cause around 6,000 fires in the home across the country every year.

The Peak Smoke Alarm Campaign is offering Safe & Well Visits to people in the High Peak during the month of June 2019. A Safe & Well Visit will provide you with fire safety advice. During the visit, smoke alarms may be fitted where appropriate. A Safe & Well Visit will also identify any health and wellbeing concerns that need signposting to local services.

To qualify for this service you need to answer **YES** to question 1

1. Do you own and reside in your own property?

**+ 1 or more of the criteria below**

2. Live within Buxton, Chapel ,Whaley Bridge, Furness Vale, Chinley, Castleton, Hope, Edale, Bamford
3. Live more than 10 minutes from the nearest fire station
4. Be over 65 or between the ages of 25-45
