“ Kath, thanks for the email, the position is as we discussed a couple of weeks ago and previously, we are attempting to get consent from the landowner to replace the camera and if we get it we will enter into a licence with him to do so. As soon as the pub changes hands we will do the same with the new owner (if we haven't by that time sorted it out with the current owner).

As you will see he appears to be suggesting that there is not currently a formal agreement for the camera.

I could ask her to chase for further information, but I feel that is would be pointless because as you can see there does not seem to be any predisposition for a legal route.
