26/0179 Public Speaking – County Councillors Nigel Gourlay was present and wished to give a view on the recent court case relating to the abatement order at the MUGA.

Sooner or later the MUGA will need replacing and therefore the Parish Council should think about how much money it intends to spend on legal fees defending something that has a finite lifespan.
