### 20/231 Election of Chairman

#### 20/232 HPBC Regeneration Support Grant and Project list

High Peak Borough Council have confirmed that grant funding of £4,000 will be made available in 2018/19 subject to it being matched and fulfilling regeneration objectives. This has been confirmed as a three year commitment by High Peak Borough Council so funding can be rolled over if not fully spent in the municipal year.

This would leave an amount of £1,000 which can be used for other projects.

High Peak Borough Council have requested a list of regeneration projects for the Parish which was agreed and is attached to these minutes.

It was agreed that a speaker be invited to the next committee meeting to speak about Broadband in the Parish.

#### 20/233 Community Plan

Members of the Committee were made aware of the Community Plan which was compiled following the extensive consultation in the Parish during the preparation of the Chapel-en-le-Frith Neighbourhood Plan. The Community Plan consists of issues that residents highlighted during the consultations but were not eligible for inclusion in the Neighbourhood Plan.

#### 20/234 Town Centre Vacancy rates

The National Town Centre Vacancy rate was 10/4% in April 2019 and 6.3% in Chapelen-le-Frith.

## 20/235 Green Tourist Signs

It was agreed that community groups should be encouraged to advertise events on the 5 green tourist signs at the entrances to Chapel-en-le-Frith. The cost of this would be met by the regeneration budget.

## 20/236 2020/21 Budget

It was agreed that £5,000 be requested for the 2020/21 budget allocation.
