

An Adjourned Meeting of the Chapelcote with

The Council proceeded to the 1<sup>st</sup> Business on the Agenda -  
The voting of Salaries to Surveyors of Highways

Salaries of Surveyors Mr Lomas (B) Proposed Mr Lomas (J) Seconded  
"That the Salaries of Surveyors of Highways be  
as follows - The Surveyor of Bradshaw Edge £ 10  
The Surveyor of Bowden Edge £ 10  
The Surveyor of Corns Edge £ 5

Carried unanimously

A Deputation from the Lighting Inspectors was then received,  
in accordance with notice given at the previous Meeting

Deputation from the Lighting Inspectors The Deputation consisted of the following persons -  
Mr Howarth Mr Collier  
Mr Boycott Mr Bowle  
Mr Sidebottom. Secretary

Mr Boycott stated that the Lighting Inspectors had decided  
Not to transfer their Powers to the Parish Council, for the present -  
And although the Inspectors had signified their intention  
at a previous Meeting to hand over their powers, still upon  
further consideration, it was thought that the Council  
would have sufficient work to do for some time, without  
having to manage the Lighting Business. The Inspectors had  
therefore decided to retain their powers for another  
Year.

Mr Reynolds and the Chairman having replied, Mr Boycott thanked the Council for the patient hearing which they had given him.

The Secretary (Mr Sidebottom) then served a notice on the Chairman of the Council to the effect that the Lighting Inspectors were ready to produce their accounts and Vouchers for the year ending March 14<sup>th</sup> 1895.

The Deputation then withdrew
