 Jewson Reynolds, of Chapelcleeve, Mr George Lomas of Sunstead  
 and Mr Keyworth of Dove Holes, be appointed Trustees for  
 Kirks, and Walkers, Charities. in place of Churchwardens and  
 Overseers.
